BREEDER PROMISE

As a pet professional and your puppy's breeder, I guarantee this puppy to the best of my knowledge to be healthy and guarantee that it has received a minimum of one round of vaccines and at least one de-worming. It is also microchipped in the new owner's name for identification and safety. Your puppy has been raised in a gentle home environment and fed premium food. Your puppy has received loving care and has been socialized with children and adults alike. He/she has also had an introduction to potty training and basic puppy commands.

OWNER RESPONSIBILITY

After leaving our premises, the new owner assumes responsibility for the safety and wellness of this puppy. This includes but is not limited to sickness, accidents, personal injury or theft. The breeder is not responsible for refunds due to human allergies, disability, illness or other related situations. The breeder is not responsible for refunds due to color change in coat, not bonding with the puppy or because the temperament is not what you expected.

The owner assumes all financial responsibility for the puppy including but not limited to vet expense, training, AKC/CKC registrations, food, surgeries, boarding, grooming, etc.

The owner assumes responsibility to continue quality healthcare for the puppy. This puppy will require worming (orally) and a series of vaccinations. You are highly encouraged to keep your puppy current with all necessary vet checks. Your puppy will also require bathing and professional grooming as part of its regular health routine. To qualify for our Health Guarantee, the new owner must agree to keep their new puppy on an exclusive diet of Life's Abundance dog food as their puppy/dog's primary diet (see below).

ADOPTION EXAM

You have 5 business days to take the puppy to a licensed vet for a full wellness exam.

If, at this physical, the vet finds a health defect in the puppy that cannot be rectified, the breeder agrees to refund the purchase price upon the return of the puppy to the breeder. A

refund will only be given upon a written report from the vet responsible for performing the exam. The vet will need to provide the breeder with all test results and diagnosis in WRITING.

This refund will only be given provided that the breeder's vet of choice verifies the defect. Viral & bacterial colds or the presence of parasites such as worms, coccidian, or giardia (bloody stools) does not make a puppy defective, as these are easily treated and common among puppies as they encounter more of the natural world and adjust to a new home and environment. We attempt to send your puppy home parasite free, and vaccinate each puppy as recommended by the AKC. After the above date this section of the guarantee is not valid.

CONDITIONAL HEALTH GUARANTEE

I provide a 26-month (2 year) guarantee against genetic severe Hip Dysplasia and Retinal Eye Disease. Because 60% of all canine hip dysplasia is related to poor nutrition, I require that the new owner continues to feed their Doodle EXCLUSIVELY Life's Abundance Nutritional Systems for the first 26 months of his/her life in order to qualify for this two year health guarantee. This guarantee starts from the date of birth and is only good for the original owners.

In regards to the wellbeing of your puppy, an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure! Remaining on Life's Abundance Nutritional Systems helps maintain optimal nutrition and wellness for your pet. This protects the guarantee as proper nutrition and feeding according to the instructions prevents obesity, a weakened immune system, and nutritional deficiencies. As an ethical breeder, I PennHIP and OFA certify my bloodlines against Hip Dysplasia and Retinal Eye Disease. I have never had a puppy with either of these genetic issues. Along with proper nutrition and exercise, the likelihood of your puppy developing these defects is extremely low.

Canine Hip Dysplasia can be officially diagnosed after 24 months of age. This guarantee allows two months for official testing to be performed. The diagnosis must be determined by the OFA (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals) after 24 months of age, and the radiographs performed by an accredited veterinarian. A diagnosis of severe genetic Hip Dysplasia requiring surgery makes the owner eligible for our health guarantee. To diagnose Retinal Eye Disease, a CERF qualified veterinarian must confirm any hereditary eye defects. The test results must be sent to the breeder by the veterinarian responsible for the diagnoses, along with scans/x-rays.

If the buyer has responsibly maintained proper nutrition as recommended for these first 26 months and either genetic defect is confirmed, the buyer can choose one of two options: a) to receive a full refund of their puppy purchase price and keep and care for their dog, or b) return the affected dog to the breeder and receive a replacement puppy as soon as possible, and I the breeder will care for the dog. The breeder will provide the replacement puppy when available from the next litter of the same breed and price range, shipping expenses (if applicable) to be paid by the dog owner.

LIFETIME COMMITMENT

Bringing home a new puppy is a lifetime commitment. As a new puppy owner, you are assuming responsibility for the love, care, and wellness of this puppy/dog for its whole life. Excepting temporary boarding purposes, this puppy is not to be sent to an animal shelter, pound, or like facility at any time. If for any reason the owner cannot keep the puppy, the puppy must be returned to the breeder with no exchange of funds. If re-homing the puppy/dog is necessary, I the breeder will find a suitable new home for the puppy/dog after thorough screening and approval.

This puppy has been raised for companionship, agility, therapy, hunting, and other domestic service purposes only. It is not to be used for breeding purposes at any time. I do not require a spay/neuter contract, as this is the responsibility of the new owner. However, breaching our no-breeding contract is punishable by law.
